GENERAL MEETING

June 5, 2018

A. The meeting was called to order by President, Sophia Day, at 6:35 PM.

Michelle Gaudinier spoke about the Educational Outreach that was recently held at the Nevada City School of the Arts. Volunteers from our guild inspired the children to create their projects. Several of their projects were shown.

B. Judy Hamilton, scholarship chair, introduced Garrett Gallardo from Nevada Union High School, as the recipient of this year's guild scholarship. He currently works at Ben Franklin and in the Fall will attend California Institute of the Arts in Santa Clarita. Examples of his knitting were shown.

2. Sue Miller, Susie Hardy, Kris Cook, Mary Serpa, and Sophia Day have volunteered to chair next year's show.
3. Marjorie McConnell, Community Service, announced that Pavana has joined Community Service as another Co-Chair along with Nancy Holtz. There are 58 quilts that need quilting and many more that need binding.
4. Rena Wittkopf is moving and has a sewing table and hutch free.
5. Molly Cook will be the Chair in 2019 for Country Store and is looking for a co chair.
6. Lori Jacobi, Quarter Yard raffle, announced there will now be 5 winners instead of 4 every month.
7. Raedeen Kidwell, Program Chair, announced there are several spaces for Mel Beach's 2 day class, tomorrow and June 7. In November, Geri Patterson Puntas will lecture

about the artist within. October's program will feature Julie Silver, a quilt appraiser.

8. Barbara Ceresa, 2018 Quilt Show Chair, read an email from 2 attendees who praised our show. She expressed her gratitude for all the hard work at the quilt show.
9. Mary Serpa talked about the 2019 Opportunity Quilt which is hand quilted.
10. Frances O'Brien, representing the Bent Needle Divas, announced they will be in charge of this year's Jamboree which will be held on Saturday, October 27. There are 4 classes to choose from. Sign ups are available now.
11. Bent Needle Divas are also supervising the construction of the 2020 Opportunity Quilt. The pattern is from Karen Stone and is named Cinco de Maya. It will be paper pieced and kits are available. There will be a refresher workshop in September on paper piecing.
12. Lois Hodges, Quilt Challenge, is taking sign ups. The total perimeter must be less than 144 inches. A member will pick a letter from a bag. There needs to be three items on the quilt front that begin with that letter. The quilt will be due at the March 2019 meeting.
13. Bonnie Lattin-Hensel, Home Work Shop, announced no Home Work Shop in June. July 26 will be Crazy 9 patch. No meeting in August. September's class will be paper piecing taught by Karle deProsse. Sophia Day will teach a purse class in October. There are no classes in November or December.
14. Karle deProsse expressed an apology from Julie Silver, an appraiser at the Quilt Show. She has been ill and unable to get the appraisals out in a timely manner. They should arrive soon.
15. Gina Boyd from the Flying Needles Quilt Guild in Woodland spoke about their Opportunity Quilt.
