

## PINE TREE QUILT GUILD OF NEVADA COUNTY GENERAL MEETING, MAY 2, 2017

**CALL TO ORDER:** The meeting was called to order by President Susie Hardy at 6:30 p.m.

**VISITING OPPORTUNITY QUILTS:** Susie introduced two visiting opportunity quilts

1. Golden Valley Quilt Guild's "Flower Garden" quilt displayed by Phyllis and Faith.
2. Folsom History Museum's vintage late 1800's quilt to publicize their "Home Is Where The Heart Is" vintage quilt and fashion exhibit March 25<sup>th</sup> - June 4<sup>th</sup>.

**JUNE PROGRAM ANNOUNCEMENT** - Heidi Emmett for Raedean Kidwell

Heidi displayed the "Twisted Up" class sample by Dorie Javier who will teach the Speaker Workshop in June. There are still openings in the class - see Margaret Vodicka to sign up.

**GUILD CHALLENGE** - Lois Hodges

Lois announced that three quilts were submitted for the challenge theme "What's Your Quilting Journey?" Members were asked to view the quilts hanging in the back hall and submit their votes for a variety of categories. Winners will be announced at the close of the meeting tonight.

**COMMUNITY SERVICE RELOCATION** - Karle deProse, Finance Chair

Karle gave background and current information on the need to relocate Community Services beginning in June since the current location, Western Sierra Youth Build Charter School, will be closing. The new location which includes good storage, will be the old Armory Building, currently the Historical Society's office, located at the intersection of Ridge, Zion, and Nevada City Highway. It will be rented on a month-by-month basis, until a more suitable facility can be arranged. The main obstacle with most available options is the lack of adequate storage space. The new space is not permitted to be used as a sewing workspace, so other guild workgroups will be unable to utilize it. Karle addressed questions raised regarding room use, and budgetary concerns, and referred those with additional questions to see her following the meeting or to see other Board members who approved the move.

**QUILT SHOW** - Jeanne Pincha-Tulley: Quilt Show this weekend May 6-7!

1. To date entry forms have been submitted for 65 quilts to be judged, and 253 quilts to be shown.
