1. Lillian Glaeser introduced the 2021 PTQG scholarship recipient Anika Paredes who was welcomed by Scholarship Chairman Sue Marshall. Anika is a graduating senior at Nevada Union who will be pursuing an art degree at Sierra College next year, with plans of transferring to the Academy of Art in San Francisco. She shared photos of her artwork using the Apple pencil software, including her creations for video game design. She also works in paint and plans to use her award for art supplies and a laptop. She thanked the Guild for her selection and thinks it would be fun to learn to quilt. A thank you to the Guild also came from Anika's grandmother Margaret Vodicka.
