1. The Jamboree, scheduled for October, has been cancelled due to the uncertainty of the Covid-19 environment. The event has been re-scheduled for October 2, 2021.
2. There is an inquiry to the guild looking for a long-arm quilter who can provide basting-only services. More information can be obtained from Lillian if anyone is interested.
3. Guild meeting activity since the last in-person general meeting has been limited to board meetings conducted via Zoom. Tonight's meeting is the first use of the guild's purchased \$15 month-to-month Zoom program subscription which allows up to 100 participants with unlimited meeting minutes. A larger program is available if member participation grows.
