The first quilts will be presented mid-October. These quilts can be any size. Larger quilts would be perfect. Then, in late November, quilts will be given to Veterans confined to wheelchairs. Those quilts should measure approximately 42x50.

I have kits and/or fabrics available if you would like to design your own quilt. All quilts should have a patriotic theme. You can get ideas by googling “Quilts of Valor,” “Wounded Warrior Quilts” or just “Patriotic Quilts.”

Completed quilts can be dropped off at Villa Rosa Designs in Grass Valley.

OUR 2023 GUILD CHALLENGE

We hope you are already thinking about and brainstorming on how to meet our “Paint Chip” challenge. Remember, it can be traditional, modern, and/or artsy. All levels of quilters are encouraged to enter.

Choose a paint chip to your liking. Be sure there are Dark, Medium, and Light color shades featured on your Paint Chip Card, as these shades must be incorporated into your quilt.

- Any technique(s) can be used. The quilt cannot be larger than 40" per side and must be completely finished.
- Fabric guidance: The Paint Chip Color in Dark, Medium and Light shades which may be patterned or solid. The only other colors allowed are Black, White, and/or Cream. No other colors may be incorporated.
- A 3X5 index card with your quilt title, a brief description plus your Paint Chip sample pinned onto the quilt or attached to your index card.

We look forward to seeing your “Paint Chip” Challenge Quilts in March.

CHUTNEY SPREAD

Adapted by Julie Berry from Ardy Tobin's recipe

Mix together

2 8-ounce packages of softened cream cheese (one low fat and one regular)

3 T. mayonnaise

2 ½ t. curry powder

½ t. seasoning mix that has flake salt, garlic, onion, pepper and herbs (use your favorite that has similar ingredients)

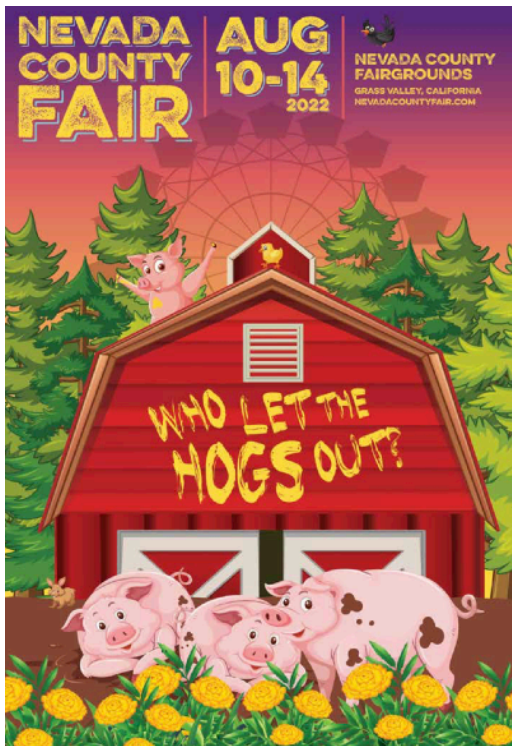
Add -

Small handful of chopped chives

Snack size box of raisins that were soaked in raspberry liqueur (or your favorite beverage)

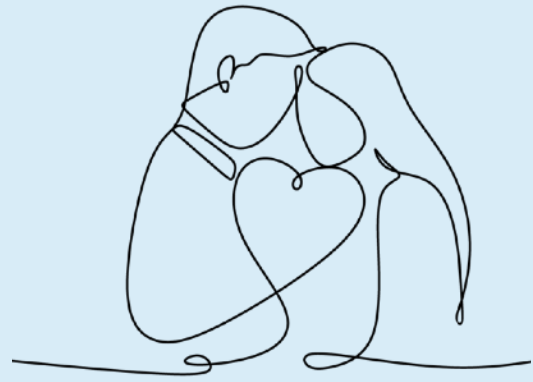
