

Precision Piecing Tip from Mariah Bath

To help eliminate the stretch from the bias on the basket block and achieve a quarter inch seam allowance on the outside edge of the block, I figured out that the best way is to do a partial seam. See examples A and B below.

A Begin with the basket bottom up so you can see the corner. Sew halfway across.



B Next turn the piece so the handle side is up and sew from the opposite to the middle. Presto! No stretching out of shape.
